Hi! This is Guide Contemporary

It's just one of the Sweeble template designs - we've got lots more, have a look at the example newsletters.

Guide Contemporary is a modern design with several colour options, built especially for carrying listings of events. We've used it here to show how it would work as a hyper-local magazine, but it also works as an event programme, or classified ads freesheet.

As with all Sweeble templates, you have a choice of around a dozen different page layouts, giving you lots of options. This is a four-page example, but you can produce magazines of up to 32 pages, and 25 to 5000 full colour copies. All the work is done online through Sweeble - no need to buy software or pay a designer to do it, Sweeble is DIY micro-publishing.

Papers set to axe news jobs

Journalists in Hull, East Yorkshire and north Lincolnshire are braced for job cuts as recession bites.

The publisher of the Hull Daily Mail and the Grimsby and Scunthorpe Telegraphs plans to trim about 50 posts from its editorial staff.

Northcliffe Media wants to create news pages from new centralised production centres in Hull and Nottingham. It said it was consulting staff, but no firm decisions had yet been taken.

The company said journalists in Hull would produce the editorial pages for the Hull Daily Mail, Grimsby Telegraph, Scunthorpe Telegraph and Lincolnshire Echo. Only last month, the company closed its printing press in Grimsby with the loss of 58 jobs as it streamlined its printing operations.

Flooding plans revealed

Plans have been unveiled to prevent a repeat of serious flooding in Hesse.

Hesse was among several parts of East Yorkshire to suffer in the floods in June 2007.

The Environment Agency is considering creating flood storage areas on land north of Boothferry Road to reduce flooding from the Western Drain. An agency investigation concluded that the root cause of the flooding in 2007 was the limited capacity of the Western Drain culvert.

Project manager Keith Crawford said: "We are now looking in more detail at the options for a scheme to reduce risk. "We need to find out which option will be the best overall solution for Western Drain. We aim to select the best solution by May."
